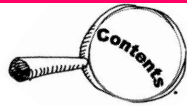


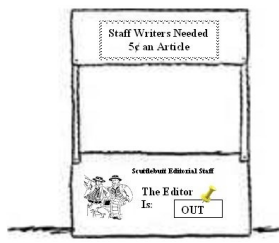

Editorial Comment

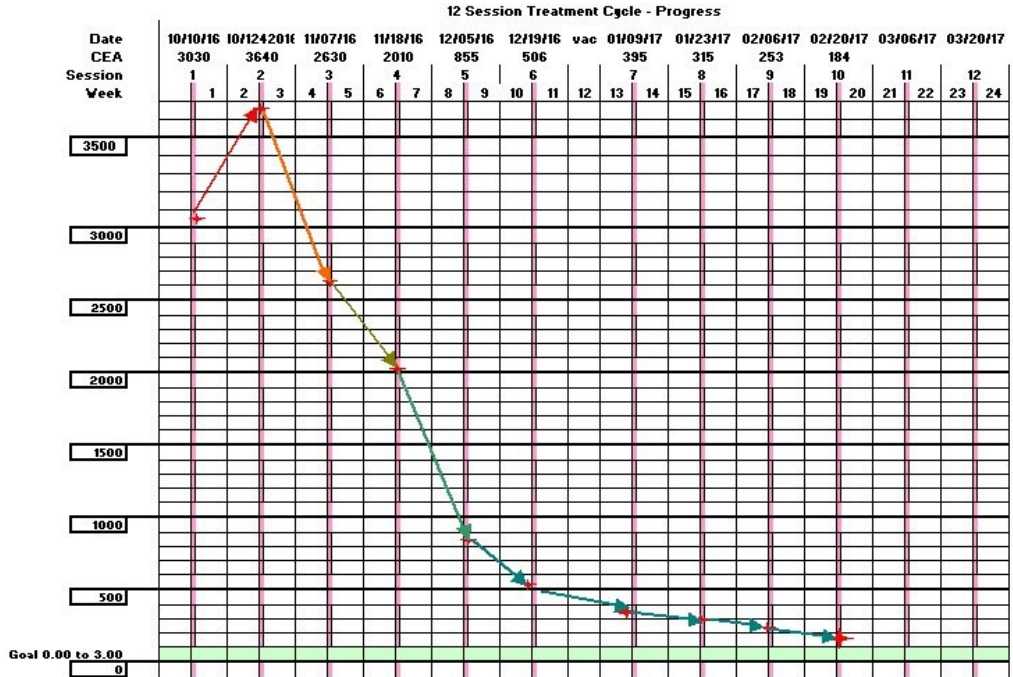
